The 2025 Schwartz Reisman Canada Israel Exchange offers you:

- Approx. 2 weeks in Canada (Halifax and Toronto) and 2 weeks in Israel (pending the Government of Canada reducing the risk level for travel to Israel)*
- Meetings with Canadian and Israeli business leaders
- Education on Canadian culture and business practices
- Fully covered airfare, hotel, ground transportation, and entrance fees
- An exciting chance to study abroad

If you are interested in meeting new people, experiencing a new culture, and visiting historical places, then this exchange is for you! Possible activities include winery tours in Nova Scotia, Ontario and Israel, boat tours of Niagara Falls, kayaking in the Atlantic Ocean and visiting the highest tides in the world. You will also be able to introduce your Canadian peers to the many sites and historic places in Israel.

***In case we cannot travel to Israel, the entire program will take place in Nova Scotia and Ontario.**

How much will the program cost me?

The program is almost fully funded by a donation from The Gerald Schwartz & Heather Reisman Foundation. TAU students will pay a Cdn\$750 (approx. 2100 NIS) registration fee after acceptance into the program. Airfare, hotel, transportation, entrance fees to all events and tour guide fees will be covered by the donation.
