Areas of Study Requiring College Approval	Students must have the proper academic background in business (marketing preferred). This information should be provided at the time the student is officially nominated to the exchange program by their home institution.
Minimum & Maximum Credits Per Semester	Exchange students must enroll in a minimum of 12 credits each semester to be considered a 'full time' student. A typical semester course load is 12 – 15 credits, which is 4 – 5 classes. 1 UniBa credit = 7 hours.
